Boil Water Notice Rescinded May 5, 2024

On May 3, 2024, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the City of Livingston public water system, (1870002), to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The areas effected include Enchanted Forrest subdivision, Thunder Mountain subdivision, customers on Brittany Ln, and Southpoint shopping center.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of May 5, 2024.
